Biographical and Other Notes

Taylor Combe, numismatist, educated at Harrow and Oriel College, Oxford. Keeper of Coins, 1803, and of Antiquities, 1807-36 in the British Museum. Combe had plates made of Iron Age and Anglo-Saxon coins, which were later used by Ruding. His numismatic and classical library was sold in 2548 lots over 12 days by Sotheby in 1826.
