## Biographical and Other Notes

Founder member of the Numismatic Society of London (1836). Employed in the Bank of England for 48 years, the last 28 in the Bullion Office “A position which afforded him facilities for acquiring some of the rarest specimens in the later series of English coins”. Sale included 5 Dorrien & Magens shillings of 1798! Collection sold over 18 days in 1854 by Sotheby.
