Biographical and Other Notes

Born in Syston near Leicester, he always lived in the East Midland counties: Leicester, Nottingham and Derby. He converted from stamps to coins in his late teens. The salary of a physics teacher precluded a significant collection of hammered coins from the local mints and other coins, but he collected tokens (17th, 18th, and 19th C tokens) and all paranumismatica from his three counties, especially the pub checks. Early member of the Nottinghamshire NS, founding member of the Derbyshire NS, member of the BNS and Token Corresponding Society since its foundation in 1971. 19 lots of tokens DNW 18 March 2015.
