### Biographical and Other Notes

Born in Warlingham, Surrey, an interest in history and geography led to a collection of Roman and foreign coins before he left school. He trained as an accountant, becoming a tax specialist. He had a good general collection, especially English silver from the 17<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> C by 1950 when he started to collect tradesmens tokens, initially copper and latterly silver. On his staged retirement in 1970 he devoted much more time to his hobby. Collection of silver tokens sold in 69 lots by DNW 1 October 2014.
