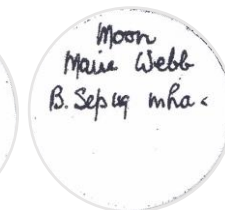
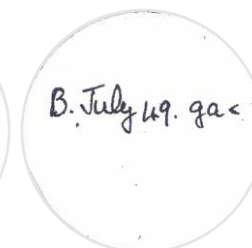
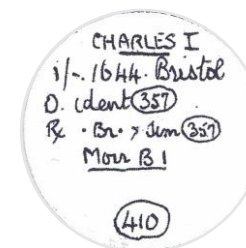
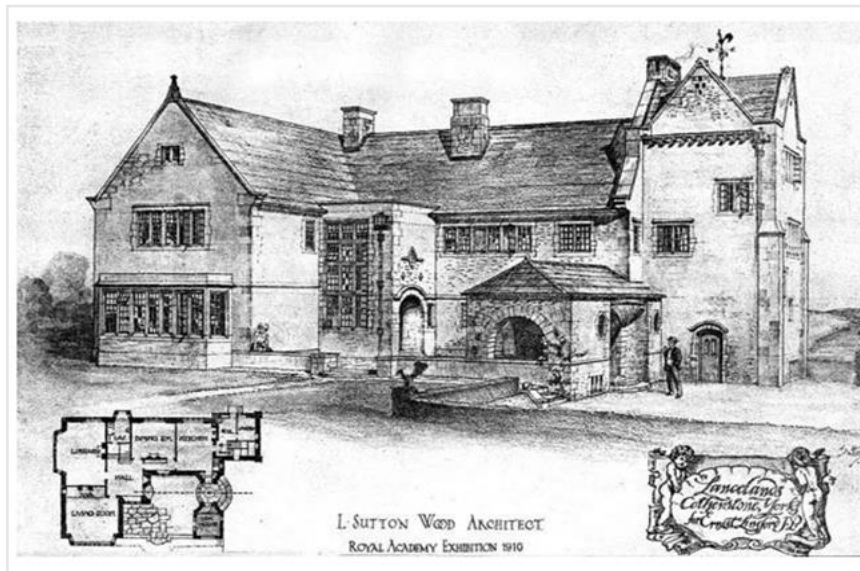


Lingford, Herbert Muschamp

Biographical and Other Notes

Third generation owner of the family provisions supplier business and manufacturer of Lingford's Baking Powder. Initially at Bishop Auckland, moved to Lancelands, Cothelstone near Barnard Castle, Co. Durham.

Important collection of Charles I silver pound and 10s pieces, crowns of Great Britain and Ireland including gold and silver patterns, Bank of England and private tokens – Glendinings 24-6 October 1950. Gold, Silver and Copper of James VI / I etc. 20-21 June 1921. Residue to Baldwin.
