



### Biographical and Other Notes

Appointed Assistant Librarian at the BM in 1784, succeeding Andrew Gifford. Main interests were Anglo-Saxon, tokens, “dollars of the world”. Instrumental in guiding Rogers Ruding to write his *Annals of the Coinage*. Charles Combe catalogued his collection which was bought en bloc by Samuel Tyssen. The duplicates were sold through Leigh and Sotheby in 1895. The books and prints were sold in 2955 lots over 11 days also by Leigh and Sotheby.
