Regulations

1. The Library is housed in the Warburg Institute which is normally open on weekdays (Saturday till 1 p.m.) with the exception of public holidays.
2. Every Fellow or member is entitled to borrow any four volumes at any one time. This rule may be modified on application to the Librarian.
3. When books are taken from the Library, entry must be made on the BOOK-CARD found inside each book of the borrower's name and date, and the BOOK-CARD placed in the box provided on the Librarian's table. Books may be sent by Post at the request and cost of Borrower.
4. No book can be retained longer than THREE MONTHS but may be again borrowed for another three months and re-entered, provided no application shall have been made meanwhile, for the book, by any other Fellow or Member.
5. Returned-books should be placed on the Librarian's table and not on the shelves, or be sent by Post at cost of borrower.
